

DESCRIPTION

Ultracoat ReNewIt Cleaner is a high-performance, spot-free cleaning and rinsing solution designed to remove any remaining Ultracoat ReNewIt Remover and dirt as the second step in preparing LVT, VCT, resilient, wood or bamboo flooring to be recoated with floor finish. It can also be used as a general cleaner for all flooring types.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS

- Removes contaminants on the surface
- Ready to use, with no dilution required
- Leaves no residue

WHERE TO USE

- To clean and prepare LVT, VCT, resilient, wood and bamboo flooring after Ultracoat ReNewIt Remover application and before Ultracoat ReNewIt Primer placement for new wear-layer application
- For general cleaning of all flooring types

LIMITATIONS

- Do not dilute. Ultracoat ReNewIt Cleaner comes ready to use.
- Do not combine with Ultracoat ReNewIt Remover.
- Do not flood the flooring surface with the solution.
- Do not use as part of a recoating system for oil-treated or wax-finished floors.

SURFACE PREPARATION

- For recoating applications, the flooring surface must be first cleaned completely using *Ultracoat ReNewIt Remover*.
- For general cleaning, the flooring surface should be clean and free from loose dirt and debris. Vacuum the floor before cleaning.

MIXING

Before product use, take appropriate safety precautions. Refer to the Safety Data Sheet for details.

• No mixing is required. The product is ready to use.

PRODUCT APPLICATION

Read all installation instructions thoroughly before installation.

Manual Method

- I. Pour *Ultracoat ReNewIt Cleaner* into a clean wash bucket.
- 2. Saturate a clean microfiber mop with the liquid. Mop the surface of the floor, rinsing the mop head often to avoid dirt builtup.
- 3. Repeat the above procedure until the entire floor has been cleaned. Clean or replace the microfiber mop head as necessary if it becomes overly contaminated, to avoid redepositing dirt on the surface.
- Do not rinse the surface. Ultracoat ReNewlt Cleaner will not leave any
 residue on the surface.

Automatic Floor Scrubber Method

I. Pour *Ultracoat ReNewIt Cleaner* into the floor scrubber's solution tank.



Follow the floor scrubber's operating procedures for proper use and clean the entire surface. For areas unreachable by the floor scrubber, follow the instructions above for the manual method. Do not rinse the surface.

PROTECTION

 Protect the cleaned floor from traffic, dirt and debris until it can be coated with *Ultracoat ReNewIt Primer*, followed by an application of *Ultracoat HT 2K*.


