# **Ultracoat Easy**

Standard-Performance, Water-Based, Polyurethane Wood-Flooring Finish









# **DESCRIPTION**

Ultracoat<sup>®</sup> Easy is an economical, one-component, water-based wood-flooring finish that is available in the gloss levels of matte, satin and semi-gloss. Suitable for use in interior residential applications, Ultracoat Easy is a self-crosslinking, aliphatic polyurethane resin base with excellent abrasion resistance for solid, presanded wood floors.

### **FEATURES AND BENEFITS**

# WHERE TO USE

- For finishing new sanded solid or pre-sanded engineered wood flooring
- For coating existing wood flooring

### **LIMITATIONS**

- Use *Ultracoat Easy* only at temperatures between 50°F and 95°F (10°C and 35°C).
- Do not apply on exterior surfaces.
- Do not use in areas subject to extremely high pedestrian traffic.
- Do not mix lot numbers of product for the same application area.
- The humidity level in the wood must be in accordance with industry standards.

### **SUITABLE SUBSTRATES**

Sanded wood flooring sealed with Ultracoat sanding sealers

Consult MAPEI's Technical Services Department for installation recommendations regarding substrates and conditions not listed.

### SURFACE PREPARATION

- Sand the wood floor according to accepted industry practices to obtain a surface that is smooth and free of oil, grease, wax, silicone and old finishes.
- Thoroughly vacuum off all dust and debris before applying *Ultracoat Easy*.

### **MIXING**

Before product use, take appropriate safety precautions. Refer to the Safety Data Sheet for details.

- 1. Gently shake *Ultracoat Easy* in the container before use and let the product stand for 5 to 10 minutes before applying.
- 2. At application temperatures greater than 85°F (29°C), dilute the product with 10% water to retard the dry time and increase workability.

### PRODUCT APPLICATION

Read all installation instructions thoroughly before installation.

- 1. Use only clean containers and tools. Do not put leftover mixed quantities of the product back into its original container.
- 2. For instructions regarding multi-coat applications, refer to the *Ultracoat* installation guide in the Products for Wood Flooring section of MAPEI's Website.
- 3. Pour a ribbon of *Ultracoat Easy* measuring 4" to 6" (10 to 15 cm) wide directly onto the surface of the wood flooring, parallel with the direction of the wood grain.
- 4. Using a microfiber head on a T-bar applicator, pull the finish in a direction parallel with the wood grain. Maintain a wet edge at all times by holding the applicator at a 45-degree "snow-plow" angle and pulling it to spread the sealer. At the end of each turn, "pad out" the applicator parallel to the wet edge to unload the fill (that is, push out the excess product from the applicator head). Do not leave puddles on the surface after application. Small areas can be reached with a high-quality paintbrush or microfiber trim pad.
- 5. Lightly sand the surface using a floor-buffing machine equipped with a maroon pad, or a 180- or 220-grit sanding screen. Remove all dust using a high-performance vacuum. Tack-cloth the vacuumed surface to ensure that all dust and debris have been removed.

### **CLEANUP**

• Residue of *Ultracoat Easy* on tools may be removed with water while the product is still fresh. Once hardened, the product must be removed mechanically.

# **PROTECTION**

- The complete curing process of *Ultracoat Easy* takes about 7 days, although it might seem hard and dry after 24 hours (75% cured after 1 day, 90% after 3 days). The floor finish may be walked on carefully after 24 hours and opened to heavy traffic after 38 to 48 hours, but it remains susceptible to scuffing or marring until it is completely cured.
- Avoid walking on the surface with hard-soled shoes or any footwear that could bring in abrasive debris from the outdoors during the curing period. Walking with socks only on the feet is highly recommended.
- Furniture may be placed onto the floor 3 days after installation (when 90% cured). Do not drag or slide furniture. Do not replace area rugs until the floor has fully cured (after 7 days).
- Use only a dry microfiber mop or cloth for cleaning during the first week.
