



MAX GRIP Carpet Installation Tape INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



The installation surface should be clean, dry, and debris free. Apply **MAX GRIP** tape liner side up. Press the tape strip firmly to the floor / surface (see A). Firmly adhere the first few inches, and then unroll a foot or two at a time, letting the tape lay over the substrate. Apply firm pressure for a secure bond in place. **Do NOT apply on top of finished flooring such as carpet, laminate or wood flooring as permanent damage may occur.**



Placement Recommendation: Apply strips to the perimeter of the room, down the center, along doorways and across the interior of the room (see B). Always follow the floor manufacturer's specific installation guidelines.



Once flooring is in place, roll back carpet to expose the **MAX GRIP** Tape. (see C). Remove the liner in sections. Once each section is removed, use a weighted hand roller to secure the flooring into the tape. For seams, apply strip under pre-cut seam, remove liner and press both sides of the seam firmly into the adhesive. Finish by rolling the seam with a weighted hand roller.

Do NOT apply on top of finished flooring such as carpet, laminate or wood flooring as permanent damage may occur. Installation tip: A carpet seam roller should be used to set the tape and flooring material into place. For best cutting results, use a utility knife.
