DESCRIPTION

Ultrabond ECO[®] 2285 is recommended for seaming/sealing most types of carpet in a direct glue-down installation. *Ultrabond ECO* 2285 can also be used in double-stick applications.

MIXING

Before product use, take appropriate safety precautions. Refer to the Safety Data Sheet for details.

• Ready to use; no mixing is necessary.

PRODUCT APPLICATION

Read all installation instructions thoroughly before installation.

Using as a seam adhesive:

- 1. Open the bottle and remove the safety seal.
- 2. Replace the bottle spout and cut 1/4" (6 mm) off the tip.
- 3. Apply a 1/4" (6 mm) bead of *Ultrabond ECO 2285* along one side of the trimmed carpet edge, where the face yarn enters the primary backing.
- 4. Carefully join the cut edges by moving the unsealed carpeting into the wet adhesive bead, within 10 minutes under normal conditions. *Ultrabond ECO 2285* is designed to seal the two carpet edges at the primary backing.

Using as a seam sealer:

- 1. Open the bottle and remove the safety seal.
- 2. Replace the bottle spout and cut 1/4" (6 mm) off the tip.
- 3. Attach the seam sealer's applicator tip.
- 4. Using gentle pressure on the bottle, apply a 1/8" (3 mm) bead of seam sealer to the carpet edge, taking care not to get material on the yarn face.
- 5. Using a thumb and forefinger, work the seam sealer into the carpet backing.
- 6. Allow the seam sealer to completely dry before seaming, using standard hot-melt seam tapes.

CLEANUP

- Promptly clean any adhesive smudges from the flooring material's surface with water while the adhesive is still fresh/wet.
- Clean tools with water while the adhesive is still fresh/wet.
- If the adhesive has dried, clean with mineral spirits. Use caution with mineral spirits, which may be harmful to some materials.

PROTECTION

• Protect from light traffic for 24 hours, and from heavy traffic for 48 hours.
